In 1805, Madame Clicquot, a young widow of 27 years, took over the reins of the House founded in Reims in 1772 and became one of the first business women in history. With her innate sense of luxury, audacious and visionary, she made her Champagne known to the world. The perfect combination of boldness and elegance, for over 200 years Veuve Clicquot has stayed true to its motto, 'Only one quality, the finest'. This is now synonymous around the world with outstanding luxury.

Veuve Clicquot privileges excellence and quality, using grapes from predominately Grands and Premier Crus and only using the juice from the Cuvée (the first and only pressing of the grapes). The Champagne is dominated by Pinot Noir, with Chardonnay bringing its elegance, freshness and delicacy and finally Pinot Meunier delivering the fruit. The signature brand of the House is the brut non-vintage blend known around the world as Yellow Label, however Veuve Clicquot are also known for their vintage brands in particular La Grande Dame.

Steeped in history, Veuve Clicquot and Cunard are renowned for their commitment to the finest quality.
